WHAT TO BRING:

Bible, pencil/pen, notebook

Clothes:

Bring cool, comfortable, MODEST clothing and sleepwear. NO SHORTS! Jeans, Capris or long pants.

Students and staff are required to wear their event T-shirts and lanyards during all activities. You may not wear flip-flops during outside activities. Please bring sneakers.

Personal Needs:

Sleeping bag and/or blankets, pillow, towels, and personal hygiene items. An inflatable mattress is recommended.

Students requiring medications must bring (1) all medications in original containers, (2) a written list of all medications and (3) basic instructions for intake. For safety reasons, medications will be collected upon arrival and administered daily by adult staff.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Do not pack any electronic devices including phones. They will be collected at the beginning and given back at the end of the week. Magazines, knives, cigarettes/tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, fireworks, and firearms are prohibited.

Possession of any of the above items will result in expulsion from The Faith Into Action Youth Conference. Parents will receive a phone call to pick-up their teen.
