### OPENING ACTIVITY

#### **Get Your Head in the Game**

*Made to Create: an activity that explores spiritual ideas through the process of drawing, building, and designing*

**What You Need:** Creative building supplies

#### **What You Do:**

- **Instruct** kids to get in groups of three and work together to build the greatest place a kid could ever go.
- **Encourage** them to think about what would be there, what would NOT be there, etc.
- **Suggest** that they decide on a plan as a team before they get started.
- When they finish (or after they've used up their allotted time), **let** each group explain what they created.
- **Guide** everyone to vote on which creation is best but without voting for their own.

#### **What You Say:**

"You built some really great places today. I'd like to spend a day in each of them! *[Transition]* **But today we're going to talk about the best place ever. Let's watch the video to hear about what the Bible says will turn out better than we can ever imagine.**"

## **BIBLE STORY ACTIVITY**

### **Take a Snapshot**

[Talk about God | Bible Story Review]

*Made to Move: an activity that increases the oxygen in the brain and taps into the energy in the body*

**What You Need:** Two sets of “Heaven Game Cards” Activity Page, “Heaven Game Signs” Activity Page, painter’s tape

### **What You Do:**

- **Hang** the “In Heaven” and “Not In Heaven” signs on the wall (or lay them on the floor next to each other.
- **Divide** the group into two teams.
- **Create** a start line (across from the wall signs, about 15 feet away) using the tape and instruct kids to line up in their teams behind the line.
- **Scatter** the two sets of cards around the room or around your small group space.
- **Assign** each team a different color of cards to collect.
- **Explain** that when you say “Go,” one person from each team run to a card of their team’s color and pick it up.
  - As a team, kids will decide if what’s written on the card is something that will be in heaven or not.
  - Then the kid who picked up the card should run down and put it in the correct column (using tape if the signs are on the wall), run back, and tag the next person on their team.
  - The two teams will be sharing one set of columns, but will each have its own set of cards.
  - Kids will continue the race until they have placed each of the 16 cards in the correct column.
  - The first group to finish putting all cards in the correct column and sit down together as a team wins!

## **BIBLE STORY ACTIVITY**

**[Talk about God | Bible Story Review]**

*Made to Imagine: an activity that promotes empathy and facilitates biblical application through role-play and reenactment*

**What You Need:** Crayons, markers, paper, pencils, and Bibles

**What You Do:**

- **Pass** out the crayons, markers, paper and instruct kids to spread out.
- **Explain** that John saw a vision from God and had the challenge of putting it into words.
  - **Ask** kids to imagine what it would've been like to try to find words to describe a vision from God!
- **Tell** them that they now have the job of hearing John's words and painting a picture of what they think John is describing.
- **Encourage** kids to draw or color whatever comes to mind as you read the Scripture. (NirV is quoted below for your convenience.)
- **Read** the verses aloud slowly.
- **Repeat** the verses every two or three minutes as kids paint.
  - I heard a loud voice from the throne. It said, "Look! God now makes his home with the people. He will live with them. They will be his people. And God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death.' And there will be no more sadness. There will be no more crying or pain. Things are no longer the way they used to be. He who was sitting on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Revelation 21:3-5a
- **Remind** kids that just like we don't know exactly what John is describing or what his vision looked like, we don't know exactly what heaven will be like.

But we do know that following Jesus will turn out greater than we can imagine.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

**[Live for God | Application Activity]**

*Made to Connect: an activity that invites kids to share with others and build on their understanding*

**What You Need:** No supplies needed

**What You Do:**

**Ask:**

- What would it be like to not have any sadness, pain, or anything bad happening to you?
- What else do you think heaven will have or not have?
- What part of heaven do you hope for the most? What are you really hoping is true of heaven or what would you be most excited about?
- Is there anything about heaven that makes you nervous? What would that be?

## **PRAYER ACTIVITY**

**[Pray to God | Prayer Activity]**

*Made to Reflect: an activity that creates space for personal understanding and application*

**What You Need:** No supplies needed

**What You Do:**

- **Gather** your group together.
- **Take** a moment to point out that God always hears us when we pray—whether it's with a group or alone, out loud or in silence, heads bowed or eyes wide open as you walk.
  - There's no one particular way you have to pray, but we often bow our heads and close our eyes to help us focus.

- **Explain** that you're going to pray aloud for your whole group and that you'll be pausing for them to think or to pray silently along the way.
- "Thank you, LORD, for loving us so much that You made a way for us to be with You forever."  
(Pause)  
"Thank You for Jesus and thank You for heaven. We know that You have gone to get heaven ready for us, Your Word tells us so."  
(Pause)  
"We know that if we trust You God, we will get to spend forever in heaven with You."  
(Pause)  
"We look forward to heaven even though we don't know what it's like and don't know what to expect."  
(Pause)  
"Sometimes the unknown is almost scary, but we know that in heaven everything will be made perfect and we will never have to be separated from You."  
(Pause)  
"Thank you for the Bible that tells us Your story—and thank You for keeping Your promises."  
(Pause)  
"We need You! It's in Your Son's name that we pray, amen!"
